## **COVID-19 Policies and Procedures for Golfers**

### **Updated as of May 10, 2021**

If you feel any symptoms such as Cough, Headache, Fever or Difficulty Breathing – PLEASE STAY HOME!

- MASKS are MANDATORY when entering the clubhouse. Physical distance of two metres must be maintained at all times between customers not of the same household.
- Tee times are MANDATORY. NO WALK-ONS OR INQUIRY VISITS. ALL Golfers must check-in at the clubhouse prior to golfing. (this includes back 9)
- Tee times are limited to members of the same household; or if living alone, to two close contacts. Arrive no more than 10-15 minutes prior to your tee time. Please call to book 780-354-2538, or visit our website [www.riverbendgolfcc.ca](http://www.riverbendgolfcc.ca)
- No more than 5 golfers in the clubhouse at a time. Please use sanitizer provided before entering the clubhouse. Food and beverage available for takeout orders only. (Patio CLOSED as of May 10)
- The Driving Range is closed until further notice.
- Golf carts should only be used by one individual or members of one household at a time. Please return them to the driving range after each round to be sanitized. Carts are available on a first come first serve basis.
- PACE of PLAY – 10 minute tee times. A round should take no more than to 2 hours. No groups larger than a foursome. All outdoor social gatherings must be limited to no more than 5 people and a maximum of 2 household cohorts. Do not search for balls in trees or water. Keep your group moving.
- Flags are to remain in the entire time. Rakes, benches and ball washers have been removed from the course. DO NOT touch any other equipment than your own.
- No handshakes, high fives, fist bumps or any other form of contact. Physical distance of two metres must be maintained at all times between golfers not of the same household.

These procedures are for your safety, the safety of your playing partners, and the safety of Riverbend Golf & Country Club Staff.
